I am requesting \$1,100,000.00 for the Enhancing South Kingstown Town Beach: Resilience and Accessibility Upgrades Project in fiscal year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Town of South Kingstown, located at 180 High Street, South Kingstown, Rhode Island 02879. The funding would be used to enhance the resilience and accessibility of South Kingstown's Town Beach, including by relocating an existing playground and restroom facility vulnerable to storm damage, making Americans with Disabilities Act accessibility enhancements, and implementing various shoreline resiliency measures to restore and fortify the coastline. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will help protect public infrastructure, promote accessibility, preserve a valuable public asset, enhance community resilience, promote environmental sustainability, and improve quality of life for residents and visitors.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is consistent with purposes authorized in 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(2), 5305(a)(4), and 5305(a)(5).
