I am requesting \$791,014 for the West Warwick Police Department Equipment for Crisis and Investigation Response Project in fiscal year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Town of West Warwick on behalf of the West Warwick Police Department, located at 1170 Main St., West Warwick, RI 02893-4829.

The funding will be used to purchase and upfit emergency response vehicles that will allow the police department to improve hazard mitigation, investigations, and personnel and public safety. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because the vehicles will enhance response capabilities for West Warwick's police officers and increase safety and responsiveness for residents.
