I am requesting \$1,500,000 for the Johnston Ball Fields at Woodlake Park for Flood Mitigation and Recreation in Fiscal Year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Town of Johnston, located at 103 Reservoir Avenue, Johnston, RI 02919. The funding would be used to relocate a public park in order to allow the Town to perform flood mitigation by creating a retention pond at the current site.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it simultaneously addresses flooding risks to the community and provides enhanced community-building opportunities for residents. The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes described in 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(2) and 5305(a)(4).
