I am requesting \$1,500,000 for the Johnston Ball Fields at Woodlake Park for Flood Mitigation and Recreation in Fiscal Year 2026. The funding would be used to relocate a public park in order to allow the Town to perform flood mitigation by creating a retention pond at the current site.
