I am requesting \$620,000 for the North Kingstown Community Center Revitalization Project in Fiscal Year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Town of North Kingstown, located at 100 Fairway Dr, North Kingstown, RI 02852. The funding would be used to rehabilitate a vacant historic building so it is fully code compliant and meets Americans with Disabilities Act requirements for public use by community organizations with interests vital to the well-being of the entire North Kingstown community.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it revitalizes a historic Rhode Island assembly space that contributes to the character of the Wickford Historic District and transforms it into a community center for civic organizations and veteran groups.
