Dear Chairman Womack and Ranking Member Clyburn,

I am requesting \$1,380,000 for the Iglizzi Resilience Hub Renovation in Fiscal Year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Providence, located at 25 Dorrance Street, Providence, RI 02903. The funding would be used to make improvements to a community center to electrify it and allow it to maintain power and services during emergencies, including by combining the use of rooftop solar, battery energy storage systems, and generators.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will strengthen community preparedness and response capabilities that are critical to enabling the city to weather and recover from a range of potential disruptions. The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes described in 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(2) and 5305(a)(4).
