I am requesting \$1,000,000 for the City of Providence for the Providence Riverwalk in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Providence, located at 25 Dorrance St, Providence, Rhode Island 02903. The funding would be used to initiate the first phase of infrastructure improvements for the broader Waterplace Park and Memorial Boulevard corridor to include structural rehabilitation, ADA-compliant access enhancements, improved stormwater management, and measures to improve safety and visibility for pedestrians.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will benefit a wide range of the community who rely on the area and the surrounding downtown corridor for mobility, recreation, commuting, and access to transit.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes described in 23 U.S.C 133.
