I am requesting \$5,000,000 for the Town of South Kingstown for the Downtown Wakefield Main Street Reconstruction and Safety Improvements project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Town of South Kingstown, located at 180 High Street, Wakefield, Rhode Island 02879. The funding would be used to reconstruct the roadway to include upgraded sidewalks and ADA-compliant curb ramps, improved crosswalk visibility, curb extensions to reduce crossing distances, enhanced pedestrian signage, traffic calming measures, upgraded lighting, and intersection improvements.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will address long-standing safety concerns while supporting economic activity and improving accessibility for residents, visitors, and vulnerable road users. The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes described in 23 U.S.C. 133.
