I am requesting \$750,000 for the Town of South Kingstown for the Downtown Wakefield Stormwater, Access, and Parking Improvement Project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Town of South Kingstown, located at 180 High St, Wakefield, Rhode Island, 02879. The funding would be used to implement stormwater, ADA accessibility, and public infrastructure improvements to the municipal public parking area in the Downtown Wakefield village center along the Saugatucket River.
