Dear Chairman Womack and Ranking Member Clyburn,

I am requesting \$500,000 for the North Kingstown School Department for the Inclusive Playground at Fishing Cove Elementary School project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the North Kingstown School Department, located at 100 Romano Vineyard Way, Suite 120, North Kingstown, Rhode Island 2852. The funding would be used to construct a new, inclusive playground that serves all students, including those enrolled in the district's specialized special education programs housed at the school.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will fund the replacement of aging playground infrastructure at Fishing Cove Elementary School in North Kingstown, Rhode Island, with a modern, accessible playground designed to serve 300-350 students of all abilities. Federal funding will support the installation of safe, ADA-accessible playground equipment and surfacing that will allow all students to participate in outdoor play and physical activity.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes described in 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(2) and 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(5).
