I am requesting \$475,000 for the Town of Glocester for equipment to provide ambulance services in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Town of Glocester, located at 1145 Putnam Pike, Chepachet, RI 02814. The funding would be used to replace the aging frontline ambulance and modernize the town's Advanced Life Support (ALS) cardiac response capabilities.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will improve the reliability of emergency medical services, strengthen cardiac arrest response capability, and ensure uninterrupted EMS coverage for residents and visitors within Rhode Island's Second Congressional District.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized under the Public Health Service Act.
